## Oklahoma COVID-19 Risk Level



Cleveland County's current risk level (as well as most of the state's counties) is: Moderate

The Oklahoma State Department of Health has developed the Oklahoma COVID-19 Risk Level System; a four-tiered risk measurement tool with corresponding color categories that identify the current COVID-19 risk level. This tool offers the public and local elected officials an easy way to recognize each county's risk level. #### **COVID-19 Vaccine Opportunity for Children 5 and Older**
