



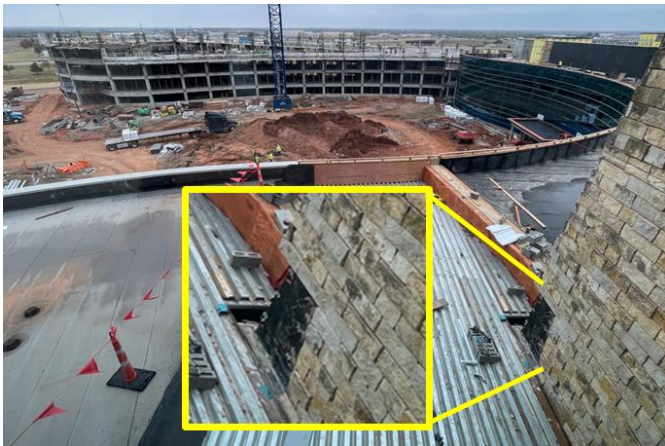

Important Timelines

- Construction on the HealthPlex stone façade continues
- If you work at the HealthPlex you will begin to hear the construction as crews move closer and closer to joining the new construction with the existing HealthPlex building
- As a reminder, Substantial Completion is when Norman Regional gets the 'keys' to the building, so to speak
- Substantial Completion dates will slide during construction due to weather and other factors
- We will share the firm Substantial Completion date soon!
- The renovation work within the existing HealthPlex will continue to ramp up
- We anticipate this renovation work to continue to require slight modification in the way we provide our day-to-day business
- The Inspire Health team will provide regular updates on the renovation, the construction, and any anticipated impacts
